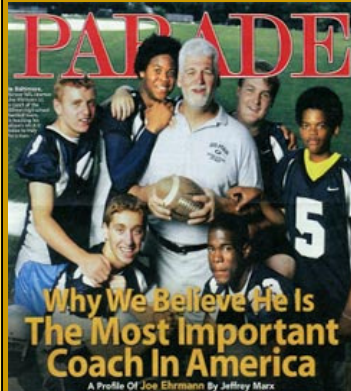

Inside-Out Coaches Clinic

On Monday July 26th over **150 coaches** from youth clubs, high schools, and colleges gathered to hear from one of the most important coaches in America. Former NFL All-Pro and current High School Coach, Joe Ehrmann has had a tremendous influence on coaches across the country over the past 10 years. Coach Joe emphatically demands that coaches use their power, position, and platform to build men of integrity and empathy. As a result Coach Joe is in the process of changing the landscape of the coaching culture in America.

During the two and a half hour seminar, Coach Joe talked through the a number of fascinating topics including the core lies of masculinity and femininity in our culture as well as identifying ways that our American sports culture both helps and hurts the development of our youth. In light of these truths each coach was required to develop a missions statement that all of their coaching decisions would be filtered through. Coach Ehrmann's Statement; *"I coach to help boys become men of empathy and integrity who will lead, be responsible and change the world for good."*
